Getting a Learner Driver Licence

Youthsafe, a Government-approved Driver Licensing Access Provider (DLAP) and Youth Employment Services (YES) have partnered to provide free support for disadvantaged people in the Hawkesbury area to get their learner licence.

Support from Youthsafe includes:

- Providing you with a fee exemption letter for the DKT
- Reimbursement of the cost of your Learner Licence (\$28)
- Free professional driving lessons up to the value of \$150

Following on from this YES (Youth Employment Services) will:

- Help to prepare you for your Driver Knowlege Test
- FREE access to five hours of professional driving lessons
