The St Marys Community and Road Education Scheme (CARES) is a purpose-built bicycle safety education facility that gives school students an interactive and fun way to learn about road safety.

The CARES program was created to assist in the reduction of risk, injury and death for young road users. It has been specifically designed for Stage 2 and Stage 3 students, as children in these age brackets are a

higher crash risk category of road users. The program supports your school in the delivery of its Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) syllabus

The CARES program teaches children how to be safe on the road as a pedestrian and as a bike rider and is delivered by the Nepean Police Area Command.

### Webbs Creek (Ferry 45) extended closure on Tuesday 6 December 2022

On the next monthly Webbs Creek (Ferry 45) service day (Tuesday 6 December), Transport for NSW will replace the cable on the ferry

To safely carry out this work, the monthly scheduled Webbs Creek service closure time (9.30 am to 12.00pm) will be extended from 9.30am to 2.30pm.

Work hours for these repairs have been scheduled to reduce impacts on community members travelling to and from work or school. The ferry service will continue to operate prior to and after the scheduled work hours.

#### How will the work affect you?

Motorists seeking to cross the river between 9.30am and 2.30pm on Tuesday 6 December will need to take a detour to the south, via St Albans Bridge which will add approximately 50 minutes to journey times

Eastbound road users will detour via St Albans Rd, Settlers Rd, Wisemans Ferry Rd, Old Northern Rd, to River Rd.

Westbound road users with detour via River Rd, Old Northern Rd, Wisemans Ferry Rd, Settlers Rd to St Albans Rd.

We appreciate this is a significant disruption and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused while we carry out this important work.

Emergency services needing to cross the river on Tuesday 6 December during the service extended closure from 12 to 2.30pm will be able to cross with a short delay of around 15 minutes to allow for the resetting of the crossing to provide ferry service. During the monthly scheduled closure time from 9.30am to 12pm and while the cable is being replaced, emergency services will need to take the detour.
